Objective: Provide comprehensive housing support for survivors of domestic violence.

Main Outcome: Helping survivors transition to a safe, stable living environment.

Eligibility:

Target: Survivors of domestic violence.

Verification: Referrals from domestic violence support organizations, police reports, or court orders. Financial assessment: Prioritize those in greatest need.

Services Offered:

Duration: Up to 2 months. Cap: No more than \$8,000 total per household. Rental Assistance: Direct payments to landlords. Upfront Costs: Covers security deposit & first and last month's rent. Utilities: Payment for services like electricity, water, gas, and internet. Trash Removal: Cost covered.
